2. **One pumpkin/entry per household will be judged!**
3. **Week of Oct. 19th – Oct. 23rd**, bring your decorated/carved pumpkin to the library.
Hours are 9-4 Mon., Wed., Fri. 3-6 on Tuesday.
4. **Week of October 26th – October 30th** pumpkins are on display and up for judging during library hours.

Your pumpkins will be judged by fellow library patrons during this week, in the following nine categories:

1. Scariest
2. Happiest
3. Best Carved
4. Best Dressed/Prettiest
5. Goofiest
6. Best **Character** from your favorite book (bring a picture of that character)
7. Best **Author** of your favorite book (bring a picture of that author)
8. Most Creative.
