Join us for a cocktail hour followed by an author talk and signing, and enjoy the opportunity to meet author Angeline Boulley in person.

Angeline Boulley's debut novel, *The Firekeeper's Daughter*, was an instant bestseller, recipient of the Printz Medal, the Walter Dean Myers Award, and the Morris Award. It will be adapted at Netflix for TV. Boulley's bestselling second novel, *Warrior Woman Unearthed*, is a sequel to *The Firekeeper's Daughter*.

Angeline Boulley, an enrolled member of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians, is a storyteller who writes about her Ojibwe community in Michigan's Upper Peninsula. She is a former Director of the Office of Indian Education at the U.S. Department of Education. Though she lives in southwest Michigan, Boulley's home will always be on Sugar Island.
